AGREED ORDER

Pursuant to its authority under §507.305 of the Texas Occupations Code, §2001.056 of the Government Code, and 22 Texas Administrative Code §884.12(e), the Executive Director for the Texas Behavioral Health Executive Council ("Council") hereby approves, ratifies, and enters this Agreed Order with the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order of Council, which have been approved and accepted by **Roger Harold Belisle Ph.D.** ("Respondent") and which constitutes a full settlement and compromise of the complaint(s) currently pending against Respondent before the Council in the above-referenced and numbered matter(s).

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent is licensed as a Psychologist (#36625) in the State of Texas and is, therefore, subject to the jurisdiction of the Council.
2. Respondent did not report this initiated action against him to the Council within thirty days of service of the formal Complaint. On or about March 7, 2023, the South Dakota Board of Examiners of Psychologist received a complaint against Respondent that alleged he "failed to take all reasonable steps to ensure that a multiple relationship with M.H. did not impair either 1) [Respondent's] professional judgement and/or (2) result in a conflict of interest, with M.H. being a client or a relevant person." On or about May 1, 2023, a formal Complaint (Doss 23-226) was served on Respondent.
3. On July 6, 2023, Respondent entered into an Agreed Disposition with the South Dakota Board of Examiner of Psychologists. Respondent agreed to a reprimand and 40 hours of preapproved continuing education pertaining to Multiple Relationships. Agreed Disposition was effective on September 8, 2023, the date that the South Dakota Board of Examiners of Psychologists voted on and accepted the disposition. Respondent's attorney informed him of the Board's acceptance on September 12, 2023. Respondent self-reported the disposition to the Council on September 28, 2023.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Respondent voluntarily received a license from the Council and, therefore, is bound by the provisions of Chapters 501 and 507 of the Texas Occupations Code and the Rules of the

Council, 22 Texas Administrative Code Parts 21 and 41.

2. Violation of the Council's Rules is unprofessional conduct and constitutes grounds for the imposition of sanctions under §§501.401 507.301, and 507.351 of the Texas Occupations Code.
3. Based on the above Findings of Fact, the Council finds that Respondent is in violation of Council Rules 22 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 884.32(a), regarding failure to timely report an initiated administrative or disciplinary action to the Council and 884.32(c), regarding reciprocal discipline.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED THAT:

1. Respondent's license is hereby REPRIMANDED.

WARNING

RESPONDENT'S FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH ONE OR MORE TERMS OF THIS ORDER MAY CONSTITUTE A VIOLATION OF 22 TEXAS ADMINISTRATIVE CODE §884.55 REQUIRING FURTHER DISCIPLINARY ACTION.

WAIVERS

On the underlying investigative file, Respondent has waived his or her right to an informal settlement conference, a formal hearing before an Administrative Law Judge at the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH), and judicial review pursuant to Texas Government Code Chapter 2001, in exchange for the conditions set out in this Agreed Order.

THE RESPONDENT, BY SIGNING THIS ORDER, AGREES TO ITS TERMS, ACKNOWLEDGES UNDERSTANDING OF THE FORMAL NOTICES, FINDINGS OF FACT, AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW SET FORTH HEREIN AND COVENANTS TO SATISFACTORILY COMPLY WITH THE MANDATES OF THIS ORDER IN A TIMELY MANNER. RESPONDENT FURTHER ACKNOWLEDGES AND AGREES THAT HE OR SHE HAS AGREED TO THIS ORDER UPON THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF COUNSEL, OR THAT HE OR SHE HAS HAD THE OPPORTUNITY TO HAVE THIS ORDER REVIEWED BY COUNSEL OF HIS OR HER CHOICE.




